

Sporting equipment packaging guide

Sporting equipment	Packaging may include	Packing requirements
Snowboarding / skiing equipment	• Binding and poles • Boots will be included in checked baggage allowance	Placed in a snowboard carrying case / snowboard box / ski bag with sufficient padding to protect the edges e.g. bubble wrap or foam padding.
Windsurf board / kite / surfing equipment	• Sails	• Fins should always be removed, or, if they cannot be removed, should be firmly packed with polystyrene foam. • Both nose and tail should have bubble wrap or neoprene foam attached for protection. • The rails (sides of the board) should have cardboard down the sides to absorb shock. • The board should be packed in a properly padded surf-bag to protect against damage.
Bicycle	• Bike only	The bike must be packed in a suitable travel bag / case, and handle bars turned sideways, pedals removed, tires deflated and other sharp or "bulky" parts removed or suitably covered.
Scuba / diving equipment	1 x scuba tank (open valves and empty) 1 x scuba regulator 1 x tank harness 1 x tank pressure gauge 1 x mask 1 x set of fins 1 x snorkel 1 x weight belt 1 x knife 1 x spear gun 1 x safety vest	• Tank pressure gauge (pressure-sensitive devices may need special packaging; refer to manufacturer). • Scuba / cylinder tank must be empty and presented at check-in for inspection. • Spear guns and harpoons must be unloaded with the spear / harpoon packed separately.

Golf equipment	• A set of golf clubs (14 clubs) • Golf balls and tees • Golf shoes will be included in checked baggage allowance	The bag and clubs must be fully enclosed in a hard-shell container specifically designed for shipping.
Fishing equipment	1 x tackle box	Must be retractable for transport and packed in a suitable hard casing.
Canoe / kayak	1 x set of paddles	Paddles must be placed in a protective bag
Sporting weapons	• 5kg of ammunition (unopened, original packaging) carried by passenger. • Must be packed in a separate box.	• Prior approval from flydubai security (at least 4 business days before your flight). • Packed in a locked hard case. If possible, stock for shotguns and firing bolt for rifles removed.
